FAMILY SPHERE

- Pray for families in Round Rock to place God's Kingdom work first on their list of priorities and give careful thought to their ways.**
 - "Is it a time for you yourselves to be living in your paneled houses, while this house remains in ruins?"- Haggai 1:4
 - "This is what the Lord Almighty says, "Give careful thought to your ways." Haggai 1:7
- Pray that families will care for widows in their own families according to God's Word and for believers to**

help widows when there is opportunity according to scripture.

- "But if a widow has children or grandchildren, these should learn first of all to put their religion into practice by caring for their own family and so repaying their parents and grandparents, for this is pleasing to God." 1 Timothy 5:4
 - "If any woman who is a believer has widows in her care, she should continue to help them and not let the church be burdened with them, so the church can help those widows who are really in need." 1 Timothy 5:16
- Pray that families would use the values outlined in God's Word such as love, service, honesty, integrity, and prayer to lead their homes. Psalm 128 is called the marriage prayer because it was often sung at the Israelite marriages.**
 - "Blessed is everyone who fears the LORD, who walks in his ways! You shall eat the fruit of the labor of your hands; you shall be blessed, and it shall be well with you. Your wife will be like a fruitful vine within your house; your children will be like olive shoots around your table. Behold, thus shall the man be blessed who fears the LORD.
