# **HERO UERSE**

"Do good! Seek peace and go after it!" Psalm 34:14B

## **MATERIALS**

- Blank shield, 1 per child
- Glitter Stickers
- Adhesive Jewels
- Colored Electrical Tape
- Multi-Surface Markers (!) & scrap paper
- Scissors
- Hero Code label

# CRAFTS: HERO SHEILD

### **Preparation**

- Separate glitter stickers. Set out jewels and stickers. Be sure to keep some back for the rest of the week.
- Set out small trash containers so children can keep the trash separate from the stickers and jewels.
- Set out colored tape. You may want to precut various size and colored strips ahead of time.



- Set a sheet of scratch paper at each station.
- If you have time, you can write the names of the children on the role on a "Hero Code" label.

### **Directions**

- 1. Give each child a shield.
- 2. Encourage them to use the tape, markers and stickers to personalize their shield.
  - (!) When using the markers, encourage the children to color carefully and over their sheet of scratch paper so they don't mark themselves and the tables. (!)
- 3. Place their Hero Code label on the "back" of their shield, near the handle.
- 4. Allow children to role play with their shields. You can talk about the Armor of God and how the shield of faith and help us face our fears.
